LMPC stands for **Legal Metrology Packaged Commodities**.

3. Businesses that Sell Measured Products

If you sell products based on weight, number, or volume (like groceries, gas, fabrics, etc.), you need to follow Legal Metrology rules. This ensures your customers get the exact quantity they pay for.

4. Packers and Re-packers

If you pack goods in containers or change packaging before selling, you also need this registration.

Why is Legal Metrology Certificate Important?

- It helps you follow government laws
- It avoids penalties or fines
- It builds trust with your customers
- It improves your chances of selling in bigger markets, including exports

What is LMPC Certificate Registration?

If you import any kind of pre-packaged product, you need an LMPC Certificate. This certificate allows you to import products legally and ensures the packaging has proper information like:

- Quantity

- Weight or volume
- Maximum Retail Price (MRP)
- Expiry date
- Manufacturer/importer details

Without LMPC registration, your goods may be stopped at customs.

What is Legal Metrology Manufacturer License Registration?

This license is required for all businesses that manufacture weight or measurement instruments.

For example, if you make digital weighing machines, petrol meters, or blood pressure monitors, you need this license. It proves your product is made according to Indian legal standards.

What is the Model Approval Certificate for Weight and Measurement Devices?

Before selling a weight or measurement device in the Indian market, you need approval for that device's design or model. This is called a [Model Approval Certificate](#).

It confirms that the device is safe, correct, and meets the technical standards.

For Example:

If you're manufacturing a digital weighing scale, the model must be tested and approved by the Legal Metrology Department before it can be sold.

How to Get a Legal Metrology Certificate?

Here is the process for getting any Legal Metrology registration:

Step 1: Identify the Type of Certificate You Need

Choose based on your business type:

- Manufacturer license
- LMPC certificate
- Dealer or repairer license
- Model approval certificate

Step 2: Collect Documents

You will need documents like:

- Identity and address proof

- Company registration certificate
- GST certificate
- Details of the products or devices
- Factory layout and machinery details (for manufacturers)

Step 3: Fill the Application Form

Submit your application online or offline to the Legal Metrology Department of your state or to the central government (for model approval).

Step 4: Pay the Government Fees

Each type of registration has a different fee. You need to pay this while submitting your application.

Step 5: Inspection and Verification

For some licenses, government officers may inspect your site or test the devices before giving approval.

Step 6: Receive the Certificate

Once everything is verified, you will receive your Legal Metrology Certificate. This usually takes 2–4 weeks depending on the state and type of license.

- You must get the LMPC Certificate before importing goods.
- The model approval certificate is needed before you start selling weighing or measuring devices.
- Renew your licenses on time to avoid cancellation.
- Display certificate numbers on your product labels when required.
