What Counts as a Dental Emergency

What Treatment Looks Like on the Day

Walking into an emergency appointment, the first goal is always to get you comfortable. Pain relief comes before anything else. Once you are settled, the dentist will assess what is happening and talk you through the options clearly and honestly.

Depending on what you are dealing with, [emergency dental services Charlotte, NC](#) can include same-day extractions, emergency fillings, crown replacements, abscess drainage, and treatment for soft tissue injuries. Knocked-out teeth can sometimes be re-implanted successfully if you arrive quickly enough — ideally within an hour of the injury.

A Few Things to Do Before You Arrive

If a tooth has been knocked out, hold it by the crown rather than the root, rinse it gently with water, and either place it back in the socket or keep it submerged in milk. For swelling, a cold compress on the outside of your cheek will help manage discomfort on the way in. Over-the-counter pain relief is fine to take, but it will not resolve the underlying problem.
