Why Prompt Treatment Matters

What to Do While You Wait for Your Appointment

If you are dealing with a dental emergency and are on your way to see us, a few simple steps can help reduce pain and protect the affected area:

Knocked-out tooth: Keep it moist. Place it back in the socket if possible, or store it in a small container of milk. Do not scrub the root.

Broken tooth: Rinse your mouth gently with warm water. Apply a cold compress to the outside of your cheek to manage swelling.

Severe toothache: Rinse with warm saltwater and avoid placing aspirin directly against the gum tissue, as this can cause tissue damage.
