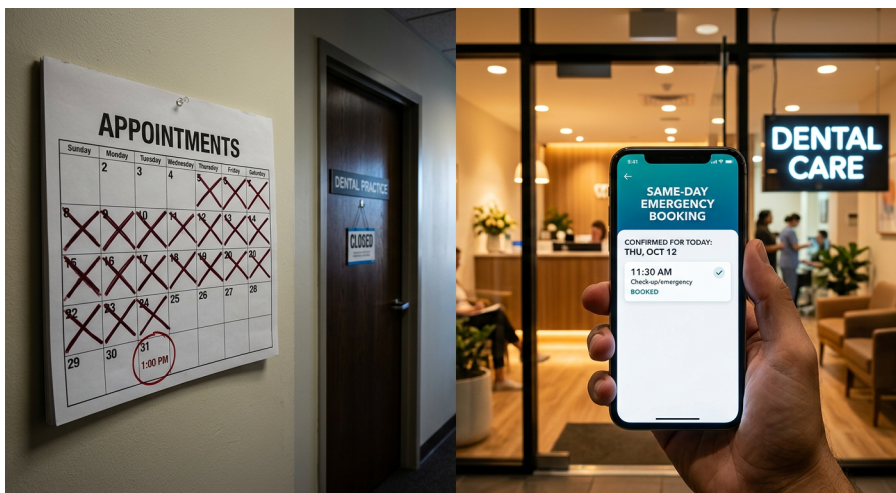


What Does an Emergency Dentist in Charlotte Actually Do Differently from a Regular Dentist?
